- The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has applied for financing from Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of **Improving Workforce Readiness in Punjab Project (IWRPP)**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
- The **Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Improving Workforce Readiness in Punjab Project (IWRPP), Industries, Commerce, Investment & Skills Development Department, Punjab, Pakistan** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for IWRPP/WORKS/CW 01(Lot 01 & Lot 02), as follows:

Package CW 01 (Lot 01): (i) Govt. Staff Training College Muree
(ii) Govt. Technical Training Institute (W), Muree
Package CW 01 (Lot 02): Vocational Training Institute, Rawalpindi

Bidders may bid for one OR both lots as described in bidding documents:

- Open Competitive Bidding (national advertisement)** will be conducted in accordance with the ADB’s [Single Stage-Two Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all eligible Bidders as described in the Bidding Document.
- Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

Participation as a contractor, Joint Venture partner, or Subcontractor, in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder’s participation in the contract exceeds the amount mentioned below. - pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 10,000/- PKR for Package CW 01 (Lot 01) and CW 01 (Lot 02) and deposit in favor of Project Director, PIU – IWRPP in shape of Demand Draft/Pay Order.

- **On or before the deadline of bid submission: 29 December 2023 at 14:00 hours (Pakistan Standard Time)**
- Together with a Bid Securing Declaration as described in the Bidding Document.

Technical Bids will be opened immediately after the bid submission deadline in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend, whereas the Financial Bid remain sealed and unopened and shall be placed locked. The Financial Bids of only Technically Responsive and Qualified Bidders shall be opened after technical bids evaluation, whereas the financial bids of those bidders whose technical bids are not responsive and qualified shall be returned unopened.
